Here are some upcoming opportunities for professional development offered by MTS.

Workshop on Workshops-September 30, 2017

Other Deadlines

- Make sure to report all changes in family status to the ISD payroll department within 90 days to ensure continued and correct coverage for your benefits plans. This also applies to spousal health and dental plans. If, because of significant changes to a spousal plan or a change in your spouse's employment you now wish to switch to the ITA plan, you have 90 days from that change to sign up with the ITA plan(s). Again, ISD payroll will have the appropriate forms.
- If you plan to access religious leave as per our collective agreement, remember that the forms must be submitted by September 30.
- The application deadline for Sabbatical Leave is February 1, but the time to start thinking about it is now. If you are considering a sabbatical leave, please contact John Bock to get the process going.
